**Client Profile:** A foundation established in 1999 to build economic self-sufficiency for women and girls in Wyoming.

**Problem:** The board needed help with building a shared vision for the future, long range strategic planning and training for new members who were passionate yet inexperienced with effective nonprofit governance.
